General guidelines for formatting your Works Cited

- Your Works Cited page should be on a separate page at the end of your paper.
- Title the page Works Cited. Do NOT italicize, bold, or underline this title. The title should be centered at the top of the paper.
- Double space all citations. Do not skip spaces between citations.
- Create a hanging indent for the second and subsequent lines of each citation. To create a hanging indent go to Paragraph → Special → Hanging in Word.
- All citations should be in alphabetical order by author's last name. If no author is listed, use the first word in the citation.
- Capitalize each word in the titles of articles and books, but do not capitalize articles (the, an), prepositions, or conjunctions should not be capitalized unless they are the first word in a title.
- Do not include titles like Dr., Sir, or Saint, or degrees like PhD. But, do include suffixes like Jr. or IV.

Basic Citation Rules:

These are the general pieces of information that MLA suggests including in each Works Cited entry. If they are available, these elements should be listed in the following order and followed by the punctuation mark associated with each element. To see specific citation instructions, please see the chart below.

- 1. Author.
- 2. Title of source.
- 3. Title of container,
- 4. Other contributors,
- 5. Version,
- 6. Number.
- 7. Publisher,
- 8. Publication date,
- 9. Location.
