# Timeline

- File FAFSA Beginning Oct 1<sup>st</sup>
- Acceptance Letter Fall/Early Spring
- Financial Aid Award Letter Sent to Accepted Students
- Apply for Outside Scholarships Spring (review deadlines)
- Fall Semester Bills Issued Early Summer
- Fall Semester Bills Due Early-Mid July



# 2023-2024 FAFSA

- **Available October 1**
- Request FSA ID student and parent
- Based on tax information from 2021
- Report marital status/assets as of the day the FAFSA was filed
- Calculates Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
- Add up to 10 schools



# FSA ID

- Sign FAFSA electronically
- Will be used by student and parent every year
- Only the owner should create an FSA ID

## Create a New FSA ID

New to FSA? **Create an FSA ID** account below. An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member.

You are not allowed to have an employee or agent of a commercial entity, or other third party, create an FSA ID for you for any purposes including but not limited to: payment reductions, debt consolidation or applying for aid. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

- Must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an eligible degree seeking program
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Show that you are qualified to obtain a college degree

- May be estimated – additional information needed before final award issued
- Follow college/university instructions carefully

# Submitting Additional Documents


## Verification(Inceptia)

- Random process determined by Dept. of Ed
- Must be completed to receive federal aid
- Requires tax, income, and household information
- **Start early!**

## Maryland Verification (MHEC)

- Submitted through student account
- Typically due by April 1<sup>st</sup>
- Requires Maryland-specific forms

# Types of Financial Aid



# Merit Scholarships

- Awarded after a student is admitted
- Based on Admission application
- Up to full tuition
- Generally Renewable if Academic Standards are met



# McDaniel Merit Scholarships

- **The Dorsey Scholars Program**
  - Full tuition, room and board
- **Presidential Scholarships**
- **Academic Scholarships - Up to \$30,000**
- **Legacy Scholarships: Alumni, Military, Educator's**
  - \$30,000 (resident), \$20,000 (commuter)

# MD Higher Education Commission (MHEC)

[mhec.maryland.gov](http://mhec.maryland.gov)

- Financial aid awarded to student by the State of MD for MD state residents
- Can be Based on need or merit
- Requires students to submit a FAFSA by March 1.
- Students need to create a MDCAPS account (MD College Aid Processing System)
  - MD awards students

# State Scholarships

- Educational Assistance Grant(EA)
  - FAFSA Submission by March 1
  - Need based grant
- Guaranteed Access (GA)/ McDaniel Match
  - FAFSA Submission by March 1
  - Need based grant
- Senatorial and Delegate (Legislative)
- Special Populations and Career Oriented
  - Work Force Shortage Grant
  - Veterans of Afghan-Iraqi Conflict

# External Scholarships

- Guidance Office
- Employee Benefits
- Local Foundations, Businesses, Community Organizations
- Begin researching private aid sources early



# Grants

- Federal
  - Pell Grants
  - Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
  - Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans
- State (Maryland)
  - Guaranteed Access and Educational Assistance Grant
- Institutional (Awarded by the college)



# Loans

- Federal Loans
  - Up to \$5,500 available to first year students
  - Parent PLUS loans
- Private Loans



# Work Study

- Funding for part-time jobs
- Funding must be earned through work
- Designed to be used for living expenses



# Cost of Attendance

- Direct and indirect costs
- Off campus vs. On campus
- Aid cannot exceed educational costs
- What does this ultimately mean for your aid?

# Net Price Calculator

- Available on college/university website
- Estimates out of pocket costs
- Based on your response to questions about test scores, grades, family information and finances
- Based on FAFSA for current year


